

Yuliya Shmidt has been an advisor to Commissioner Cliff Rechtschaffen at the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) since 2017 and is the primary advisor transportation electrification. Her portfolio includes affordability, natural gas general rate cases and rate design, and electric system reliability. Yuliya joined the CPUC in 2008 as an analyst for the Office of Ratepayer Advocates (ORA) where she led the renewable energy team focusing on policy and implementation of the Renewables Portfolio Standard.
